WATER DISRUPTION

sections of Hanover, Westmoreland and Trelawny affected

The National Water Commission (NWC) apologizes to customers served by the **Jerusalem Mountain** facility in **Westmoreland** and the **New Milns** pumping station in **Hanover**, for the continued disruption in their water supply. This is due to mechanical challenges at both facilities.

Due to unforeseen challenges, the NWC is forced to extend the deadline for resumption of operations at the facilities. The maintenance team is working assiduously to restore water to the affected areas by **Tuesday, June 18, 2019**.

Areas affected in Westmoreland include: **Jerusalem Mountain, Herring Piece, Mijam Mountain** and surrounding areas.

Areas affected in Hanover include: **New Milns, Welcome, Cacoon, Nyerere Farm, Haddington, Watford Hill** and **Woodland**.

At the same time, customers served by the **Troy** pumping station on **Trelawny**, are experiencing a disruption in their water due to a broken main.

Customers are being assured that every effort is being made to complete the necessary pipe repair work and restore water to the affected areas by **Saturday, June 8, 2019**.

Areas affected include: **Troy, New Hope** and **Tyre**.

The NWC regrets any inconvenience caused and craves the patience and understanding of its valued customers.
