As a result, customers served by these facilities are experiencing a disruption in their water supply.

Customers are being assured that operations will resume following the return of the power supply.

**Treasure Beach, Great Bay, Calabash Bay, Newcombe Valley, Short Hill, Joe Bowl Lane, Moxon Town, Fort Charles, Geneva, Williamsfield** served by the **Newell** facility.
