**PIPELINE INTERCONNECTION WORK TO AFFECT WATER
SUPPLY TO SECTIONS OF WESTMORELAND**

The National Water Commission (NWC) wishes to advise customers served by the **Roaring River** Treatment plant in **Westmoreland**, that they will experience a disruption in their water supply on **Tuesday, June 25, 2019**, between the hours of **7:00am** and **8:00pm**.

The disruption in supply is to facilitate pipeline interconnection work along the **Macfield to Ferris cross road**.

Areas to be affected include: **Roaring River, Shrewsbury, Carawina, Amity Crossing, Torrington, Hartford, Dunbars River, Frome, Georges Plain, Savanna-La-Mar, Big Bridge, Deans Valley, Cornwall Mountain, Barneyside, Water Works, Whithorn, Caledonia, Darliston** and surrounding areas.

The NWC apologizes for any inconvenience this necessary work may cause and urges customers to store water for use during the outlined period.
