## **POWER SUPPLY CHALLENGES DISRUPT WATER SUPPLY IN SECTIONS OF ST. ELIZABETH AND TRELAWNY**

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that, operations at the **Malvern** facility in **St. Elizabeth** and the **Barnstaple** facility in Trelawny, have been temporarily suspended due to power supply challenges. As a result, customers served by these facilities are experiencing a disruption in their water supply.

Customers are being assured that operations will resume following the return of the power supply.

Areas affected in **St. Elizabeth** include: **Mountainside, Corby, Southfield, Manningsfield, Top Hill, Seaview, Flagaman, St. Mary's, Belleview, Yardley Chase, Hampton, Bethlehem, Munro, Malvern, Brown Berry Lane, Round Hill, Parklee, Barton, Epping Forest, Congo Hole, Red Bank, Port Sea, Milksham** and surrounding areas.

Areas affected in **Trelawny** include: **Barnstaple, Westwood, Stewart Town, Jackson Hill, Mahogany Hall, Jackson Town** and surrounding areas.
