The National Water Commission (NWC) wishes to apologise to customers served by the **Greater Mandeville Water Supply system**, for the disruption in their water supply, due to power supply challenges.

Areas affected include: *Pepper, Downs, Prospect, section of New Forest, Farm, sections of Nain, Sea Air, Spur Tree, Greenvale, Hatfield, Dunrobin, Balvenie, Mandeville town, Georges Valley, Hillside, Richmond, Old England, Grey Ground, New Port, Ward Avenue, Heartease, Albion, Knock Patrick, Woodlawn Housing Scheme, Caledonia Road, Caledonia Meadows, May Day, Brumalia Road, Marshalls Pen, Mike Town, Balcarres, McKinley Road, Gordon Road and surrounding areas.*

The matter has been reported to the power service provider and normal operations will resume as soon as the matter is resolved.
