## ELECTRO-MECHANICAL CHALLENGES DISRUPT WATER SUPPLY IN SECTIONS OF ST JAMES AND TRELAWNY

The National Water Commission (NWC) wishes to apologise to customers served by the **Vaughnsfield** and **Stonehenge** pumping stations in **St. James** and the **Daniel Town** relift in **Trelawny**, for the disruption in their water supply due to electro-mechanical challenges at the facilities.

The NWC is assuring customers that it is working assiduously to resolve the challenges at the **Vaughnsfield** and **Stonehenge** pumping stations by **Tuesday, July 16** and at the **Daniel Town** relift by **Friday, July 19, 2019**.

Areas affected in St. James include: **Stonehenge, Catskin, Belfont, German Town** and sections of **Garlands**.

Areas affected in Trelawny include: **Daniel Town, Texas** and **Claremont**.
