NWC WORKING TO RESTORE WATER SUPPLY

The National Water Commission (NWC) wishes to apologise to customers served by the **Copse Relift in Hanover**, for the continued disruption in their water supply due to mechanical challenges.

The Agency had reported that water would have been restored today, **July 10, 2019**, however, further challenges made this deadline unattainable. The NWC is working assiduously to resolve the challenges and restore water by **Friday, July 19, 2019**.

Areas affected include: **Copse, Friendship, Eden and Lethe**.

At the same time, customers served by the **New Milns** pumping station in **Hanover**, are experiencing a disruption in their water supply, as a result of mechanical challenges at the facility.

Every effort is being made to resolve the challenges and restore water to the affected areas by **Friday, July 19, 2019**.

Areas affected include: **New Mills, Welcome, Cacoon, Nyere Farm, Haddington, Watford Hill, Woodland** and surrounding areas.
