**NWC WORKING TO RESTORE WATER TO SECTIONS  
OF ST. JAMES AND WESTMORELAND**

The National Water Commission (NWC) apologizes to customers served by the **Vaughnsfield** and **Stonehenge** Pumping stations in **St. James** and the **Jerusalem Mountain** facility in **Westmoreland**, for the continued disruption in their water supply, due to mechanical challenges at the facilities.

Due to unforeseen challenges, the NWC is forced to extend the deadline for resumption of operations at the facilities. The maintenance team is working assiduously to restore water to the affected areas in **St. James** by **Tuesday, July 23, 2019** and to the affected areas in **Westmoreland** by **Wednesday, July 31, 2019**.

Areas affected in **St. James** include: **German Town** and sections of **Garlands** served by the **Vaughnsfield** pumping station. **Stonehenge**, **Catskin** and **Belfont** served by the **Stonehenge** pumping station.

Areas affected in **Westmoreland** include: **Jerusalem Mountain**, **Herring Piece**, **Mijam Mountain** and surrounding areas.

The NWC regrets any inconvenience caused and craves the patience and understanding of its valued customers.
