WATER DISRUPTION IN SECTIONS OF ST. JAMES, HANOVER AND TRELAWNY

The National Water Commission (NWC) wishes to apologize to customers served by the **Dantrout** pumping station in **St. James** and the **Cascade** pumping station in **Hanover**, for the disruption in their water supply due to high turbidity.

Areas affected include:

In St. James

Dantrout, Retrieve, Marchman Road, Seaford Town, St. Leonards and Bridgewater.

In Hanover

Cascade, Ponside, Great Valley, Jericho, Retrieve, Claremount, Smithfield, Willoughby and Cold Spring.

The NWC assures customers that normal operations will resume as soon as the turbidity subsides.

At the sametime, customers served by the **Clark's Town** Deepwell in **Trelawny**, are experiencing a disruption in their water supply due to electrical challenges at the facility.

Areas affected include: **Clark's Town, Duncan's, Duncan's Hill, Hyde, Kinloss, Crawle, Gibraltar, Georgia and Logwood Walk.**

Every effort is being made to resolve the challenges and restore water to the affected areas by **Friday, July 19, 2019.**
