The National Water Commission (NWC) is apologising to customers in sections of **Manchester, Trelawny and St. James**, for the continued disruption in service due to operational challenges at some of its facilities.

Areas affected include:

Victoria Town, Queen Town, Pusey Hill, Campbell's Field, Cassava Piece, Pratville, Cross Keys, Restore, Smithfield, Grove Town, Warwick, Marlie Hill, Asia and surrounding areas served by the **Victoria Town** pumping station in **Manchester**.

Sherwood, Peidmount, Reserve and Coxheath served by the **Sherwood** pumping station in **Trelawny**.

German Town and sections of **Garlands** served by the **Vaughnsfield** pumping station in **St. James**.

Stonehenge, Catskin and Belfont served by the **Stonehenge** pumping station in **St. James**.

Every effort is being made to resolve the challenges and restore water to the affected areas by **Monday, August 5, 2019**.
