### Sections of St. Catherine and Kingston Affected by Operational Challenges

The National Water Commission is advising customers in some sections of St. Catherine and Kingston that the disruption they are currently experiencing in their water supply is as a result of operational challenges.

Affected areas are: White House, Banbury, Victoria, Orangefield, Jericho and sections of Linstead, York Street, Russel Pen, sections of Treadways.

Customers served by the Bybrook #2 and #4 Pumping Stations are also without water supply due to several broken transmission lines on the network.

Areas impacted are: Kent Village, Spanish Town Road, Molynes Road, Washington Boulevard, Sections of Downtown Kingston, Hamilton Gardens, Christian Gardens and Pen, Newland Road, Cumberland, Cedar Grove, Edgewater, Waterford, Gregory Park, Braeton, Independence City, Hellshire, Tulloch Springs and other sections of Kingston and Portmore.

Following the completion of an assessment, the Company will provide a further update regarding the resumption of operations of the plants. In the interim water will be trucked to the affected communities.

The NWC regrets any inconvenience caused and is assuring its valued customers that every effort will be made to restore regular service as soon as possible.
