EMERGENCY PIPELINE INTERCONNECTION WORK TO DISRUPT WATER SUPPLY IN SECTIONS OF WESTMORELAND

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that, operation at the **Bulstrode Treatment Plant** in **Westmoreland**, will be suspended on **Tuesday, September 3, 2019**, between the hours of **9:00 am** and **5:00 pm**.

This disruption in supply is to facilitate emergency pipeline interconnection work.

Areas to be affected include: **Burnt Savannah, Grange Hill, Toll-Gate, Fullerfield, Paul Island, Alma, Little London, Glasgow, Herring Piece, Part of Rock Spring, Broughton, Old Hope, New Hope, Bay Road, Glasgow** and surrounding areas.

The NWC regrets any inconvenience this may cause and urges customers to store water for use during the outlined period.
