EMERGENCY LEAK REPAIR WORK TO AFFECT WATER SUPPLY IN SECTIONS OF HANOVER AND WESTMORELAND

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that, operations at the *Logwood* Treatment plant in **Hanover**, will be temporarily suspended from **5:00pm** until **11:00pm** today **Tuesday, September 10, 2019**.

This temporary disruption in supply is to facilitate emergency leak repair work to an 18 inch broken main. As a result, customers in sections of **Hanover** and **Westmoreland**, who are served by this facility will be without water supply.

Areas to be affected include: **Logwood, March Town, Cave Valley, Santoy, Orange Bay, Esher, Green Island, Salt Spring, Sheffield, Cousin's Cove, Lucea, Elgin Town, Malcolm Heights, Haughton Court, Prospect, Cauldwell, Pell River, First Hill, Ginger Hill, Archwell, Saxam, Beach Road, Negril, Bloody Bay, Negril West End, Norman Manley Boulevard, New Hope, Retreat, Nonpareil and Westland Mountain.**

The NWC regrets any inconvenience this disruption may cause and craves the patience and understanding of its valued customers.
