MAINTENANCE WORK TO DISRUPT WATER SUPPLY IN SECTIONS OF MANCHESTER AND ST. ELIZABETH

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that, operations at the **Gutters Pumping station** in **Manchester**, will be temporarily suspended on **Thursday, September 19, 2019**, between the hours of **9:00am** and **2:00pm**.

This disruption in supply is to facilitate maintenance work at the facility by the Jamaica Public Service Company. As a result, customers in **Manchester** and **St. Elizabeth**, who are served by this facility will be without piped water.

Areas to be affected include: **Downs, Prospect, Sections of New Forest, Farm, sections of Nain, Sea Air, Spur Tree, Greenvale, Hatfield, Dunrobin, Balvenie, Mandeville Town, Georges Valley, Hillside, Richmond, Old England, Ward Avenue, Heartease, Albion, Knockpatrick, Woodlawn Housing scheme, Caledonia Meadows, May Day, Brumalia, Marshalls Pen, Mike Town, Lincoln, Huntley, Cedar Grove Gardens, Hopeton, Waltham, Perth Road and Wales.**

The NWC regrets any inconvenience this may cause and urges customers to store water for use during the outlined period.
